- ♦ collaborating with school administrators to establish District Strategic Plans; in 2015 initiated an annual forum to gather input from the community about educational vision and priorities
- ♦ communicating and collaborating with, and presenting to, other Town boards such as the Board of Selects, Finance Committee, Capital Committee, Planning Board, Historical Commission, the Council on Aging, and Parks & Recreation
- ♦ advocating on behalf of our students and Town with state and federal legislators, education officials, and Base command
- ♦ building community consensus around planning for a school renovation project
- ♦ negotiating contracts
- ♦ working with police, fire, and Base safety officials on school safety and security issues
